

Disaster Relief

One H.E.A.R.T.T., Inc. aims to provide disaster relief aid in the form of food, water, and therapeutic services to the severely disadvantaged who are affected by either a lack of existing community resources or a lack of funding and supplies to existing local infrastructures in the time of need. One H.E.A.R.T.T., Inc. operates and focuses its resources on communities who meet the aforementioned criteria regardless of their geographical location.

Examples of qualifying individuals and communities would be those affected by natural disasters and the displaced victims of sectarian and ethnic violence such as the devastating results of Hurricane Katrina in the states of Louisiana and Mississippi and refugees of Rwanda genocide in Africa.

11.4 million refugees are under the care of the United Nations. It is estimated that the total number of those who have been displaced has surpassed 25 million world-wide as of 2009. The total for 2006 was 9.9 million (source: The Office of the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees).

We provide disaster relief aid through organizing volunteers to serve in affected areas by coordinating and carrying out the distribution of food and water. The provisions are derived from our general fund and public support.
